The Roadrunners cordially invite you to Dance in the New Year. Wayne Pelmeare will handle the calling. Johnnie Wynn will cue the rounds. Dancing starts at 8:00 P.M. Snacks will be available throughout the dance. Tickets are \$12 in advance and \$15 at the door.

Flushing Roadrunners are hosting dances on the first and third Fridays of December this year at the Flushing United Methodist Church. On December 2 join us for the "Crazy Socks Hop". Wear your gaudiest, most outlandish pair of socks. We will also be collecting hats, socks, and mittens to be donated to charity. Rounds featuring Johnnie Wynn will kick off the dances at 7:00. Alternating Mainstream and Plus and Rounds will start at 7:30.

Our Christmas Dance on December 16 will be a family event. Bring your children and grandchildren. Let them join in the festivities starting at 7:00. Carols will be sung. Beginner dances will be called. Santa and Mrs. Claus will be here. We hope to see you there.

A special note on the December 2nd dance: Due to the Flushing Candle Walk on Main Street that evening, you will have to change your route to get to the dance.

From the East (I-75): follow Pierson Road to Elms Road. Turn right on Elms Road to Coutant (approx 0.3 mi). Turn left on Coutant to Hazelton (approx 1 mi). Turn left on Hazelton to the Church (3 blocks).

From the West: cross the Flint River bridge on Main Street and turn left immediately on Maple. Turn right on Elm Street (1 block). Turn right on Hazelton (4 blocks).

From the North: follow McKinley Road to Elm Street. Turn left on Elm Street. Turn right on Hazelton (2 blocks).

From the South travel up Seymour Road and follow the directions "From the West" or travel up Elms Road to Coutant and follow the directions "From the East".

Also plan to attend the first Tuesday Mainstream Dance on December 6. Wayne will call Mainstream tips only from 7:30 until 9:30. Prior to the dance there will be an ABC (Beginner's) Workshop from 6:30 until 7:30. Several calls will be taught and danced. No previous Square Dance experience is assumed for the ABC Workshop. This is a great way to introduce someone to Square Dancing.

The first Tuesday dance will also be a Recycle Dance. If you have any Square Dance clothing that you no longer wear, bring it to the dance so that it can either be sold or given away to someone else. Due to some large donations in the past 5 months, there are

many items to choose from this time. New dancers are encouraged to keep dancing because they get good quality clothes for little or no money. Experienced Square Dancers get room in their closets for new outfits.

Regular lessons continue 2nd and 3rd Tuesday. The Basic dances (no experience necessary, all calls used will be taught in this session) starts things off at 6:30 for one hour. The Mainstream class will be held from 7:30 until 8:30 and the Plus class will run from 8:30 until 9:30. All lessons will be held at the Flushing United Methodist Church. Everyone is welcome. In January we will begin a new lesson cycle.
